### **Overall Purpose**

- Select suitable accounting policies and apply them consistently.
- Comply with generally accepted accounting practice.
- Produce estimates that are reasonable and prudent.
- Keep proper up to date accounting records.
- Take reasonable steps for the prevention and detection of fraud and other irregularities.
- To be the responsible person (Returning Officer) for the election of members held every three years.
- Prepare the Statement of Accounts at each year end – present for audit. Distribute to members and other interested parties.
- Complete statistical returns.
- To organise and manage office staff.
